The question is no longer whether it is ethical to search for information about jurors online—but whether there is a *duty* to conduct such investigation.

Scope of Work

Conclusion

A large number of conversations were recorded. These conversations transpired in news reports as well as on Facebook, Twitter, and blogs. A total of 33 Hugafkäte biog posts were found, but as access to the blog by invitation only, the technician was only able to grab snippets of text. Eleven articles were written by Jane Doe, and one appears to have been written by John Doe. From 2010 to 2013, 213 comments associated with the pseudomy Hugafkate were recorded on several online blogs; it was observed that several of these Hugafkate comments were related to the Does' lack of financial support. Overall, there is a mix of positive and negative statements.
