- Understand the increased stress and anxieties that come hand-in-hand with an active hostile event and how to control those anxieties and stress through thorough preparation and training
- Understand the critical decision-making process and psychology behind the program. Refine decision-making skills in order to increase the likelihood of survival of staff and other stakeholders during an active hostile event
- Learn the S.T.A.F. Protocol, balancing the safety of all stakeholders during an active shooter event within your office
- Remain safe and alive during an active hostile event
